

BARNYARD/CMP BENCHREST

The purpose of St. Charles Sportsmen's Club Barnyard Benchrest is to promote the shooting sport in a competition that will get new shooters involved in the sport in a fun environment at a reasonable cost.

BARNYARD CLASS

1. North American made .22 rimfire.
2. Original stock, barrel and trigger.
3. Rifle must be a repeater, any type action allowed.
4. The rifle must retail or have a Blue Book of Gun Values 29th Edition (100% condition) for \$700 or less.
5. Glass bedding, trigger job, recrowning of barrel is allowed. No muzzle devices (tuners) allowed.
6. Rifle must weigh 7.5lbs or less with scope.
7. Scope must be 6.5X or less (variable scope OK if set at 6.5X or less).
8. Ammo must be American made and have a list price no greater than \$7.00 per box of 50 (no Federal 711B with dimpled case allowed).
9. No wind flags are allowed. Any two piece sandbag style rest may be used. Front bi-pods may be used, but will be considered as part of the total weight.

CMP CLASS

1. Any American made .22 RF target rifle purchased through the CMP (or civilian equivalent).
above rules apply except
2. No weight restriction.
3. Action may be single shot.
4. No \$\$ limit on the rifle
5. Scope must be limited to 12X.

Course of fire will be one target with 20 record shots, unlimited sighters, at 50 yards shot in 30 minutes. Best edge scoring will be used.
