

Fox Valley Sporting Clays Event

The Fox Valley Sporting Clays Event will help support the Scouting program in Baldmound, Batavia, Geneva, LaFox, Lily Lake, Mooseheart, St. Charles, Valley View, and Wayne. Proceeds from this event will be used to further the impact that Scouting has on these communities, and therefore, the future.

Our 1st annual event will be held at the St. Charles Sportsmen's Club in Elburn, IL.. The club has 15 Sporting Clays stations.

Sporting Clays courses have different stations at which clay pigeons are launched as targets. The object is to hit as many targets as possible in a round that includes 15 stations and 100 total targets. The flight of the clay pigeon varies at each station.

The event will have a shotgun start at 1 PM. Dinner and awards to conclude the event .

Prearranged teams (maximum of 6 per team) may shoot together.

Participants are required to bring their own shotgun and ammo (lead or steel). Target load only. One shotgun may be shared amongst one team.

Event Format:

- Each team consists of 6 members
- There are 15 stations at which to shoot
- Shooter brings own shotgun (teams may share a shotgun)
- Shooter brings 100 rounds (lead or steel target loads)
- Eye protection required, and ear protection will be provided
- Awards ceremony based on individuals and teams
